Becoming a Childminder Training and Courses

Description of service: The Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) states "Childminders must have completed training which helps them to understand and implement the EYFS before they can register with Ofsted or a Childminder agency." The Local Authority runs a Pre-Registration Course at regular intervals throughout the year which prospective Childminders are able to attend at a cost of £150. Other pre-registration courses for Childminders are run by external organisations however the Local Authority or the Families Information Service Hub (FISH) can not recommend or verify any quality of teaching materials within these. The Local Authority Pre-Registration Course is made up of two parts, 'Is Childminding Right for Me' and 'Becoming a Registered Childminder'. The briefing sessions entitled 'Is Childminding Right for Me' and 'Business Support' will be offered as free sessions to everyone.

Who can they help? For anyone who is thinking of becoming a Childminder, the Pre-Registration course is a good foundation about childminding and to see if it's right for you.

What happens next? You can book onto the waiting list of the next stage of training which is "Becoming a Childminder" – Course dates and times to be arranged.

How much does it cost? The two briefing sessions, each running for two and half hours are free; the cost for "Becoming a Childminder" Course is £150 per person. All information regarding further training will be explained in full on the Pre-registration course.
